



2014 Canadian closed DanceSport Championships

Information and Entry Rules for non-championship events

Only Danse Sport Québec (DSQ) and Canada DanseSport (CDS) has jurisdiction over these events.

All syllabus events will be conducted according to DSQ and CDS Rules. It is each entrant's responsibility to learn and fully comply with these Rules. Ignorance of these Rules will not be accepted as an excuse.

All competitors must be able to present their valid Regional Association membership card including proof of CRAD registration. The CDS Rules are available at: www.dancesport.ca. Danse Sport Québec rules are available at www.dansesportquebec.ca.

Competitors under 19 years of age must have the release signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Each couple is allowed to compete at their registered minimum level (e.g. Bronze) and one level above the registered minimum (e.g. Silver). Youth couples may compete in Adult categories. Senior couples may compete in Adult categories.

Start times are subject to change without notice.

DSQ reserves the right to cancel an event if there are less than three (3) couples registered.

The syllabus dress code will be strictly enforced. Refer to the CDS (www.dancesport.ca) website for full details.

There will be an extra fee for entries received and accepted after March 17, 2014 (see order form). Entries will only be accepted after the deadline if this does not necessitate further rounds. No entries will be accepted on the day of the event. Events may be cancelled if there are insufficient entries.

Each competitor must purchase a full Admission Ticket for the day of the event (daytime tickets are not valid for evening events). There are no refunds for entry fees.

The use of spray tan in changing area is strictly forbidden.

All competitors must be ready to compete at least one hour prior to their event. Competition events will not be delayed for competitors who arrive late.
